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


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

WHAT IS GST?

GST (Goods and Services Tax) is a single tax that replaces many different taxes on goods and services. It's applied when things are bought, sold, or services are provided. This helps simplify taxes and makes things clearer for businesses and people.

"GST replaced multiple taxes like Central Excise, Service Tax, VAT, CST, Octroi, and others, streamlining the tax system into a single, unified tax."

Central Goods and Services Tax (CGST) is the tax levied by the Central Government on the intra-state supply of goods and services. The revenue collected under CGST goes to the central government.

State Goods and Services Tax (SGST) is the tax levied by the state governments on the intra-state supply of goods and services. The revenue collected under SGST goes to the respective state government.

Integrated Goods and Services Tax (IGST) is applicable on inter-state transactions of goods and services. It is collected by the central government, and the revenue is then shared between the center and the destination state.




GST NO.

GST Number, also known as GSTIN, is a unique identification number provided by the government to the registered businesses and firms.


It is based on PAN card and consist of 15 digits.

HSN NO. AND SAC NO.

HSN stands for Harmonized System of Nomenclature. It is used to classify the goods for taxation and other regulatory purposes.

It consist of 8 digits which gives a unique identification to a good at international level.

Ex - Sugar → 1701





HSN NO. AND SAC NO.


SAC stands for Services Accounting Code. It is used to classify the services for taxation and other regulatory purposes.


It consist of 6 digits which gives a unique identification to a service in India.
